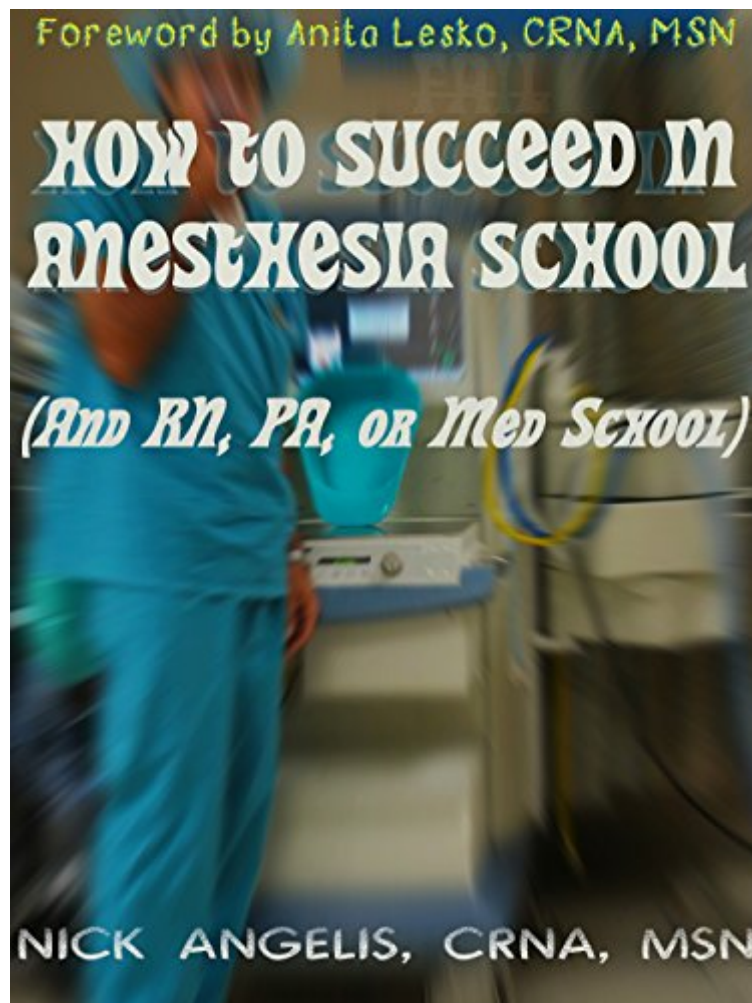




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How To Succeed In Anesthesia School (And RN, PA, Or Med School)
