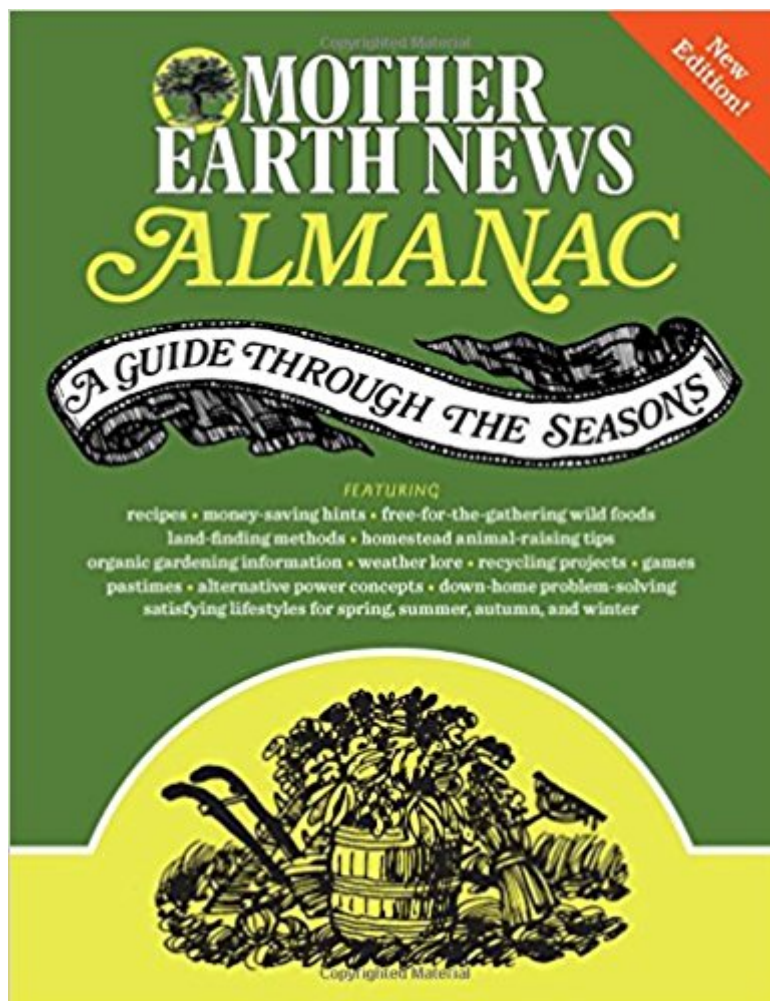


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Mother Earth News Almanac: A Guide Through The Seasons

All of the information is easy to read and understand. One won't find page after page of involved instructions but rather pertinent information which can be quickly referenced and used.
