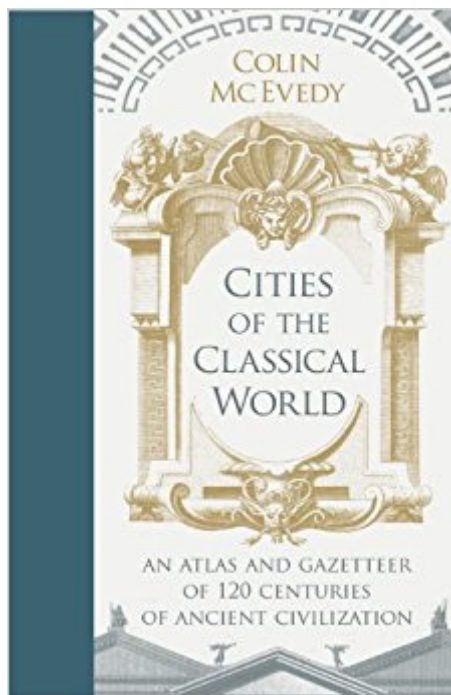




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Cities Of The Classical World: An Atlas And Gazetteer Of 120 Centres Of Ancient Civilization
